

Artist Rules And Information:

- All music must be written and performed by Newport News Shipbuilding employees.
- Lyrics must incorporate shipyard safety themes and include words from the attached list below.
- Past entries may not be resubmitted, and previous winners may not participate.
- . All genres of music will be considered.
- Lyrics may not include profanity, slurs, or any lyrics that are offensive or otherwise not in good taste.
- Music must be original, and not include any previously copyrighted music or lyrics, including parodies.
- If the judging committee finds similarities to an existing song, the entry will be disqualified.
- Up to two winners per audio song. Winners must be in good standing with the company.
- Entries are voluntary and may not be completed on company time.
- Submissions will be accepted July 15-Aug. 2.
- Top songs will be selected by a Safety Song Judging Committee based on the safety message relative to safety themes at Newport News Shipbuilding, lyrics, and song quality.

- The top five selections will be posted for voting Aug. 12-Aug. 16, via NNS to Go app. (one vote per device).
- The Safety Judging Committee reserves the right to disqualify an entry if vote manipulation is suspected. One audio winner will be announced on Aug. 21 via Currents
- The winning audio song will receive: a gift basket, a VIP tour for the winner and their family, VIP tickets to the Arkansas (SSN 800) christening ceremony for the winner and a guest, a music video professionally produced by Newport News Shipbuilding, and mentoring sessions with NNS senior leaders.
- Winners will perform at Coastal Fermentory (Address: 206 23rd St. B, Newport News, VA 23607) Thursday, Aug. 22, at 4:15 p.m. Food, beverages and music will be available from 3-7 p.m.
- All submitted entries become the property of Newport News Shipbuilding and may be used to promote future contests.

Submitting Your Audio:

- The songs must be in audio format and no longer than three minutes. Video submissions will not be considered.
- Audio songs must be submitted through an unlisted YouTube link to the EHSCommunication@hii-nns.com.
- Instructions on how to submit an audio file are here. Note: These are basic submission instructions. The artist is responsible for troubleshooting to insure their audio submission to YouTube is correct and submitted to the EHS Communications Mailbox.
- The audio song entry must be submitted with typed lyrics and a signed release form.
