Where do I drop off school supplies?

- Weatherproof Containers are located inside the gates at turnstiles for supply drop off. You can use the one by the Rock for pick-up of boxes AND drop-off of supplies.
- Set up a donation box in your area! Donation boxes can be picked up for department collections and competitions (see below). Corporate Citizenship will not be leaving boxes in lobbies. All boxes must have a person that will oversee them.

Where do I pick up donation boxes?

- **Waterfront:** Boxes will be available for pick up inside the new silver donation bin located near the Rock, 24/7, beginning July 14.
- **Outlying Buildings:**
 - **SELF SERVICE** - From July 14 - Aug. 5, boxes are available for pick up at B802-1, Net Center, Suite **173**, from 8 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. They are in the entryway of the suite.
 - **NEED HELP** - Starting July 14, boxes can be picked up at B802-1, Net Center, Suite **176**, from 8 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Requires advanced notice. Contact Juli Street.
